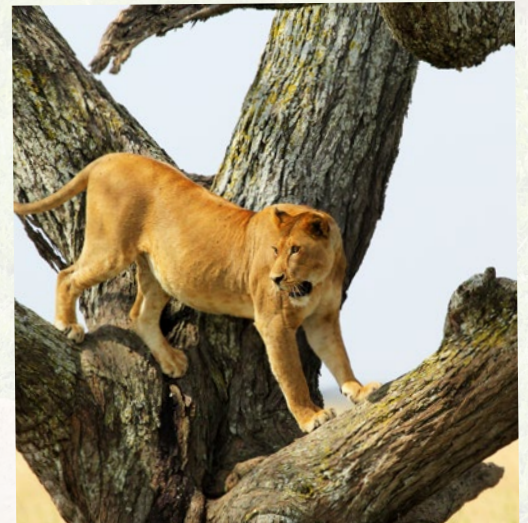
## LAKE NATRON

Lake Natron is a salt and soda lake. Part of Africa's immense Great Rift Valley, Lake Natron is famous for its flamingos and its rumoured ability to turn animals to stone!



## OLDUPAI GORGE

Oldupai Gorge is the most famous archaeological location in East Africa, and a popular stopover point for travellers coming from Serengeti or Ngorongoro.



## LAKE MANYARA

Lake Manyara National Park offers a wilderness experience in diverse habitats. Lake Manyara is a scenic gem, with a setting extolled by Ernest Hemingway as "the loveliest I had seen in Africa" and is famous for its tree climbing lions.







### TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

A favourite of all our Team, Tarangire National Park is a stunningly beautiful Park. Home to large herds of elephants, diverse landscape from swampy marshes to vast grasslands and many baobab trees. The River is a permanent feature that means abundant wildlife.



### LAKE EYASI

Lake Eyasi, just south of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area is a wild and scenically stunning area. Where you will get a real insight into the way of life of some of Tanzania's fascinating tribes, most notably the Hadzabe tribe of hunter-gatherers and the Datoga people.



### ARUSHA

Surrounded by some of the most fascinating and varied national parks in Africa, Arusha sits in a wide expanse of fertile volcanic land in the foothills of Mt Meru, Mt Kilimanjaro's little brother.



### SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK & THE GREAT MIGRATION

The Serengeti is Tanzania's oldest and most popular national park, most famous for the Great Migration crossing the Mara River. The Migration consists of up to 2 million Wildebeest, 200,000 Zebra and 350,000 Thompson, Impala and Grant's Gazelles. They migrate through the year constantly seeking fresh grazing and water. Popular times to visit the migration is August, September, October, when the migration is far north and visitors hope to catch the Mara crossing! Also through January/February is calving season in the short grass down south of the Serengeti, giving plenty of opportunity to spot the animals.



# NORTHERN SERENGETI MIGRATION.

## 8 day 7 night classic safari



## ITINERARY

**This safari allows time to immerse yourself in the Serengeti and to witness the famous wildebeest migration. From July – September the wildebeest herds gather in the North, before the infamous Mara River crossing. Tanzania has so much to offer so we also include opportunities to enjoy the colourful culture and other national parks. This Safari has the lot!**

### DAY 1: TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

Welcome! Today we will pick you up from your Arusha accommodation and take a cultural drive to Tarangire National Park, arriving in time for a picnic lunch. There is a great diversity of wildlife including lions, leopards, cheetahs, giraffes, monkeys, and a numerous variety of absolutely beautiful birds. The scenery provides a stunning backdrop for photographs. You will arrive at your Lodge in time for Sundowners overlooking the Park as the animals freely roam.

### DAY 2: LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK

As we journey across the Great Rift Valley for a full game drive in Lake Manyara we think of Ernest Hemmingway describing the setting as “the loveliest I had seen in Africa” and when you see it for yourself you’ll understand why. Lake Manyara is home to a large number of hippos. Don’t forget to look up for the tree climbing lions.

### DAY 3: HADZABE & DATOGA TRIBES

This morning we drive to Lake Eyasi for some cultural delights, visiting the Hadzabe Tribe, the last of the Hunters and Gatherers. A truly unique experience. You can also visit the traditional tribe called Datoga who are such skilful blacksmiths. This afternoon we drive a short distance to Karatu where we shall spend the night.

### DAY 4: NGORONGORO CRATER

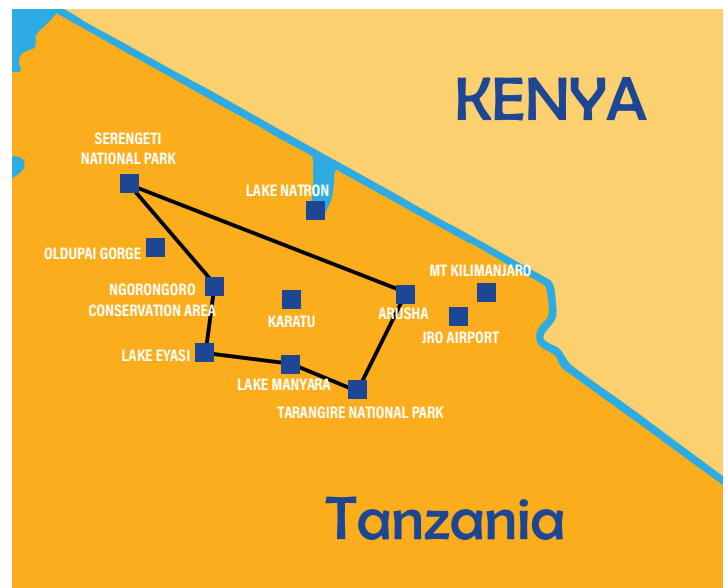
The Ngorongoro Crater is truly a Wonder of the Natural World, it is incredibly beautiful. It is one of the very rare locations where you may witness the black Rhino. As you descend into the crater have your cameras ready as this is one of the most magnificent views you will ever see. It epitomises the circle of life. From the crater we make our way into the Serengeti, a long but spectacular drive, as you pass the many Maasi Villages and more wildlife. Settle back, relax and soak it in!

### DAY 5 – 7: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Today we continue along our journey to the Northern Serengeti in search of the Great Migration. The plan for the next few days will be decided between your Guide and yourselves. Serengeti means “endless plains” and that is what you’ll experience, vast, raw and largely untouched. The Mara River is close by, and is where the Migration gather to cross in their masses, heading to greener grasses. Witnessing the herds is a spectacle itself, a river crossing the ultimate!

### DAY 8: SERENGETI GAME DRIVE & FAREWELL

A last breakfast in the Serengeti before we take you to Kogatende airport to fly out, either back to Arusha, onto Zanzibar or wherever your next destination is. By now we trust that Tanzania will have gotten under your skin and touched your heart. Memories will last a lifetime!

# SOUTHERN SERENGETI MIGRATION.

## 8 day 7 night classic safari



## ITINERARY

**This safari allows time to immerse yourself in the Serengeti and to witness the famous wildebeest migration. From December – March, the wildebeest return to the Southern plains to feed and give birth to their young in the early months of each year. Not only is the calving season so special with new lives but this also means lots of action for the Predators. Tanzania has so much to offer so we also include opportunities to enjoy the colourful culture and other national parks. This Safari has the lot!**

### DAY 1: ARUSHA TO LAKE MANYARA

Welcome! This morning we will pick you up from your Hotel in Arusha around 8.00am and start your adventures journeying across the Great Rift Valley for a full day game drive in Lake Manyara. You will see the fast-growing population of cheeky baboons and blue monkeys as well as giraffes, elephants, impalas and a huge number of buffaloes. Lake Manyara is also home to a large number of hippos. Always keep your camera poised and ready as you just never know what is around the corner.

### DAY 2-5: SOUTHERN SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

The Serengeti means “endless plains” and over three days you will have the chance to appreciate just how vast, raw and largely untouched this Park really is. Home of the great migration where 2 million wildebeest, zebras and impala move from the south to the north, following the green pastures through the seasons. For this safari they will be concentrated in the South and that is where you’ll be located. As for big cats and large predators, it is the place of choice so look out for lions, cheetahs, leopards, hyenas and more. The challenge will be to spot all of the big 5. No two days in the Serengeti are ever the same.

### DAY 5: SERENGETI – NGORONGORO CRATER

After a hot breakfast and taking a picnic lunch we farewell the Serengeti, although a part of it will remain with you always, and commence our journey to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Stopping off at points of interest along the way, we will arrive at your Lodge in time for sundowners and a good night’s rest in preparation for the Crater descent tomorrow morning.

### DAY 6: DESCEND THE NGORONGORO CRATER

The Ngorongoro Crater is truly a Wonder of the Natural World, it is incredibly beautiful. It is one of the very rare locations where you may witness the black Rhino. As you descend into the crater have your cameras ready as this is one of the most magnificent views you will ever see. It is a mini world within its natural boundaries. It epitomises the circle of life. The morning light is spectacular for photos. After a lovely lunch by the Hippo pool, we make our way back up and out of the Crater and drive on to Lake Eyasi.

### DAY 7: LAKE EYASI – THE HADZABE & DATOGA TRIBES

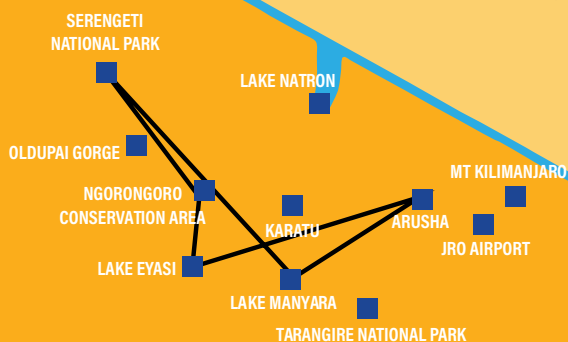
This morning we visit the Hadzabe Tribe, one of the last of the true Hunters and Gatherers, living solely off the land. A truly unique experience. You can go hunting with them and see how they shoot the animals by using arrows, skin them, roast and eat them. You can also visit the traditional tribe called Datoga. After lunch we make our way to Tarangire National Park, the third largest national park in Tanzania and a sanctuary for a very large elephant population. Observing these large elephant herds and their dynamic within is humbling. Enjoy your very last night on Safari with sundowners looking over the Tarangire River, whilst the animals roam.

### DAY 8: TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK & BACK TO ARUSHA

Majestic baobab trees are a magical feature of Tarangire National Park, providing sanctuary for many magnificent colourful birds and so tall in stature they make the animals beneath them look small. Today we meander through the rest of Tarangire National Park and make our way back to Arusha, reflecting on the magnificent sights you have seen in Tanzania. Tanzania has a way of getting under your skin and into your heart and we trust this trip will stay with you for a lifetime.

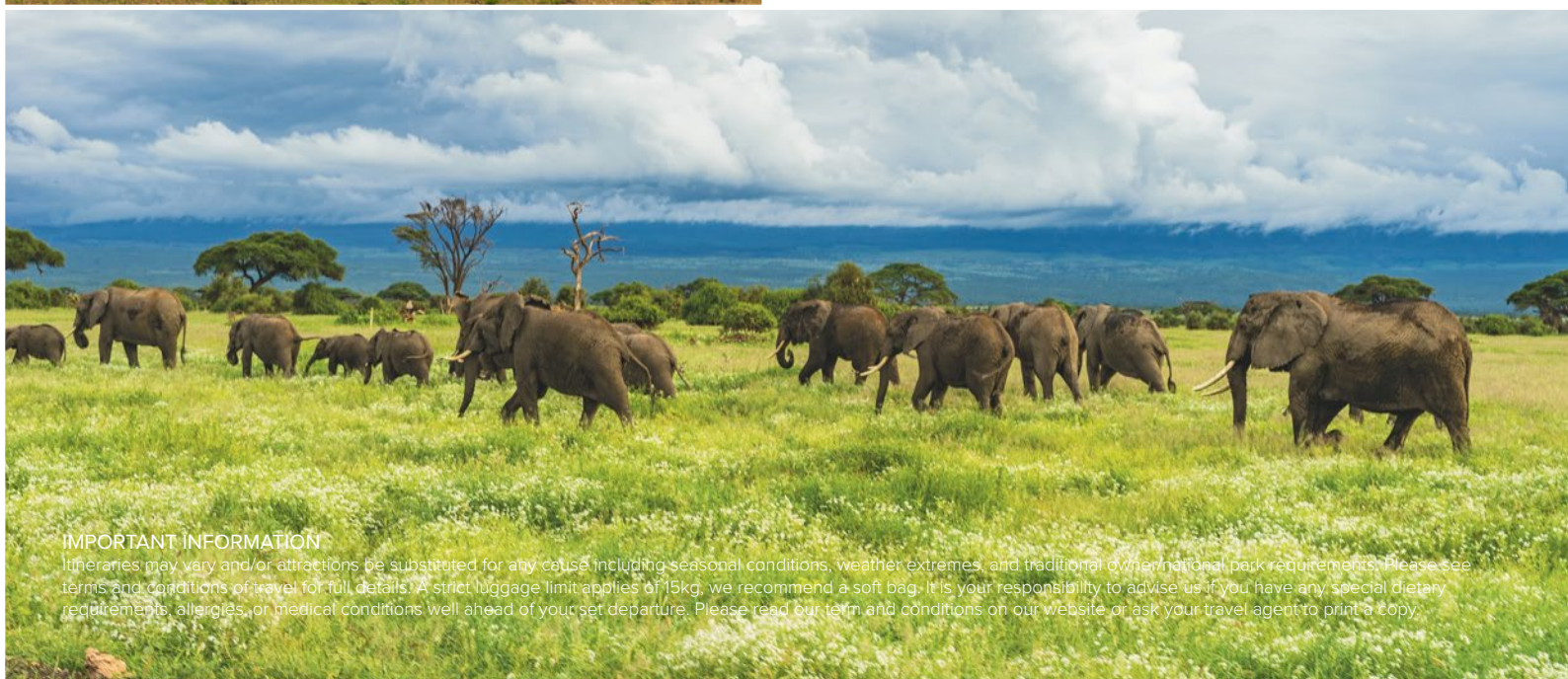
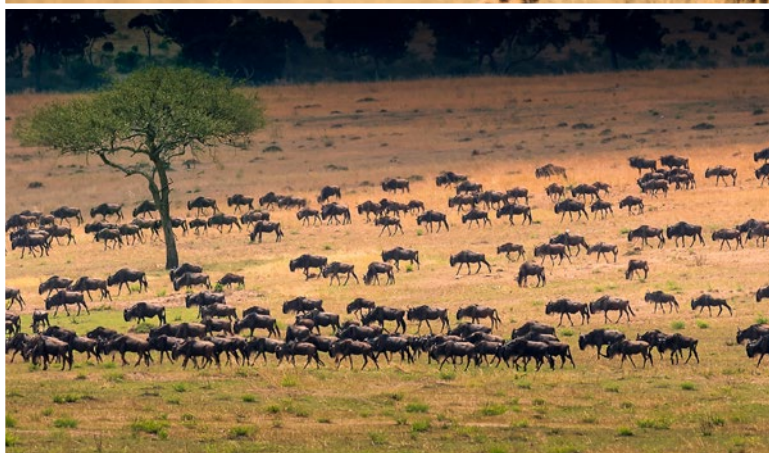

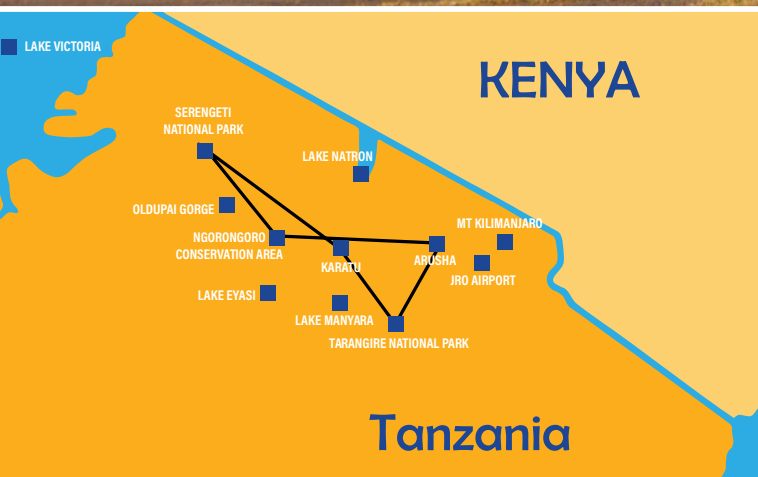

See the best of the best in just five days. This exhilarating safari adventure allows you to experience wildlife, wilderness and local culture in five short, yet action packed days.

## PRE-ACCOMMODATION:

If you arrive after midday we suggest a pre night accommodation in Arusha, which we can arrange for you. Often we use hotels such as The Outpost or Kibo Palace Hotel. This ensures your safari is not off to a rush start.

## DAY 1: PICK UP AND CULTURAL DRIVE

Pick up from Kilimanjaro Airport (JRO) or your selected pickup point or pre-accommodation. Enjoy a cultural drive of approximately 3 hours to your first destination, Either, Lake Manyara or Tarangire National Park. Overnight in Karatu.

## DAY 2: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

An early morning start from your Karatu accommodation, after breakfast heading on the road to the famous Serengeti National Park. Watch the differing landscape on your journey to the South of Serengeti where you will explore the abundance of wildlife on an afternoon game drive to your camp. Overnight Serengeti.

## DAY 3: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Early morning is one of the best times to spot some of the Serengeti wildlife, as many of the predators are out looking for breakfast. Make sure you pack your camera you will not want to forget it today! Overnight Serengeti.

## DAY 4: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

We start our day with a very early game drive in Serengeti and return to our accommodation for a late breakfast. We then travel to the incredible Ngorongoro crater rim via Oldupai and stay overnight on the Ngorongoro Crater rim.

Early morning descent into the crater with a view of the open grasslands is an experience you will never forget. Being one of Tanzania's best game drives you get many chances to see the big five, maybe even spot the elusive Black Rhino! Afternoon drive back to Arusha or Airport.

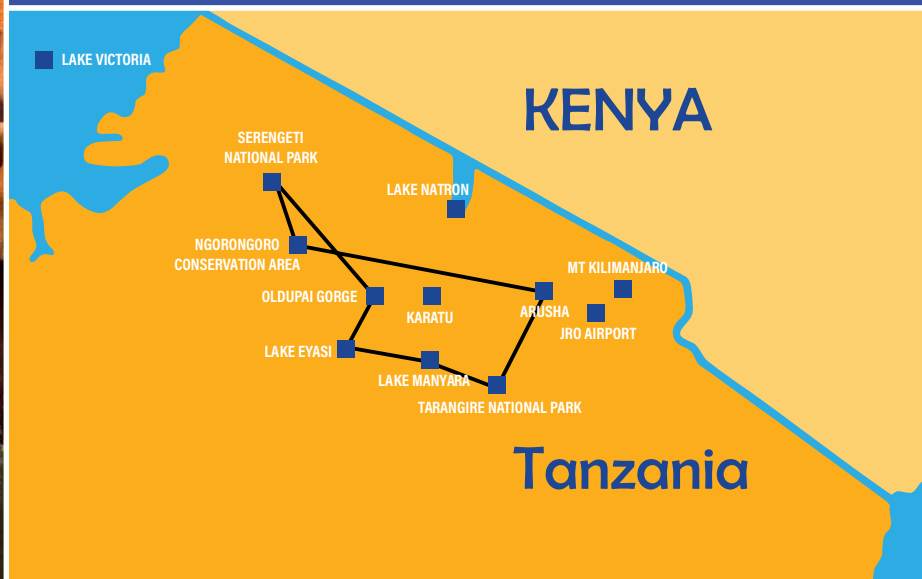

# ITINERARY

This safari ticks all the 'bucket list' boxes of inspirational, humbling and exhilarating over the seven days.

## PRE-ACCOMMODATION

To get the most out of your safari we recommend a pre-night accommodation in Arusha, which we can arrange for you. Hotels such as the Outpost to ensure you don't miss any part of your safari.

### DAY 1: ARUSHA TO TARANGIRE

Collection from either the airport or pre-accommodation. Starting with a cultural drive to Tarangire National Park where you will complete your first game drive. Many animals flock here during the dry season due to Tarangire River never drying out.

### DAY 2: LAKE MANYARA

Early breakfast before heading to Lake Manyara. Make sure you look up on this game drive, you might spot the tree-climbing lions.

### DAY 3: KARATU TO SERENGETI

On our way to Serengeti we can stop off at the historical Oldupai Gorge where some of the first human footprints are preserved. Continue to Serengeti entrance for your first overnight in the vast savannahs.

### DAY 4: SERENGETI

Enjoy an early breakfast before heading out for a full day of game drives. Try your chance at spotting the big 5, take a lunch pack for the road. An evening under canvas with wild animals roaming around you is an experience you will never forget!

### DAY 5: NGORONGORO CRATER

The children attend Tumaini TX Pre-Primary School before moving through the Tumaini Junior School, followed by the completion of their education at the Tumaini Senior Secondary School. Each trip booked with All Around Tanzania Safaris helps us to fund another child's education! These are long-term sponsorships of up to 12 years and we sincerely hope to increase the number of children sponsored each year. Your next safari can help achieve this!

## The School

Recognising the importance of teaching the English language to help train the future leaders of Tanzania, Modest Bayo and his wife Lightness set out to create a school where English would be taught from Kindergarten age onwards!

In 2004 the very first classroom was set up in Karatu inside their own loungeroom which bulged at the seams with orphans. With no outside financial help, however aided by various community members, Bayo and Lightness began digging trenches, laying foundations, mixing mortar and setting bricks all by hand, to build the schools we see there today!

Encouraged by their small community, they kept building as more children and orphans kept coming to be educated. Today the lounge-based classroom has expanded into the Tumaini Junior School which now has over 800 students! In 2016 Lightness & Bayo, in collaboration with the Tanzania Education Corp, opened the Tumaini Senior Secondary School to ensure that those students who attended the Junior School continue to receive the same standards of education throughout secondary school.

Impressively, as the Junior School continued to grow over the years, the Bayos also opened Tumaini TX Pre-Primary School, in February 2017! To date, there are over 1100 students (and climbing) across the three campuses which is such a fantastic achievement by Modest and Lightness Bayo.

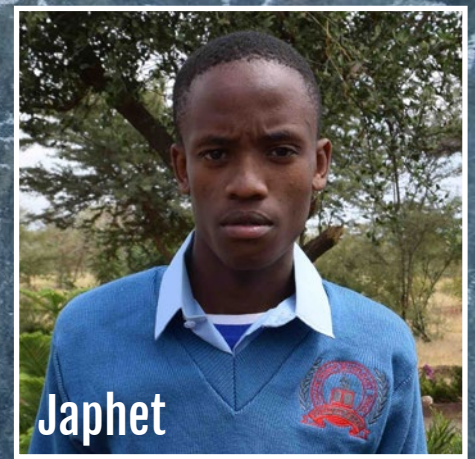
